The objective is to support the IMA and its members - people like you - in the UK. We are a small but select band, around 150 qualified CMA people working in the UK and adding value to their employers and the economy.

IMA in the UK, in Europe, in the World

The IMA, of course, is a global organisation and the CMA qualification is recognised on an international level.

How is your IMA support structured?

Within the UK, we have a single chapter representing all members who live or work here. We co-operate closely with other chapters; many of our online events are open to members anywhere.

Within Europe, we have the Europe Region of the IMA. This team coordinates activities across the continent, with several other countries also having their own chapters. The European team operate out of new headquarters in Amsterdam

The Global IMA team co-ordinate and communicate constantly with all regions. We work with them both at the chapter level and the regional level.

In this way we support our members with a lean, 'shallow-tree' management structure - very cost-effective and with short chains of communication. So when we support you, you get the full support of the region and the global!

People and Numbers

Just how big is the IMA?

In the UK we grew over the last 12 months from less than 20 to almost 150 members.

In the same period the global total reached 100,000 members

IMA Europe grew from 1,900 members in 2010 to 3,000 now.

The fastest growing IMA cohort, in absolute numbers, is China, where we now have 27,000 members - 10 years after the first Chinese version of the CMA exam.

But it is not about numbers, it is about individuals. As the IMA approaches its 100th anniversary, we are keen to highlight personal and individual stories. How has your career evolved?
